

Fines and laws fact sheet

Criteria	Law	Fine
2. Club has a current liquor licence	Operating without a liquor licence is illegal.	\$1100 on-the-spot fine for each unit of alcohol sold by way of a compliance notice, penalty action or complaint action. A maximum court penalty of \$11,000.
3. Required liquor licence signage is clearly displayed at the alcohol point-of-sale location	Breach of licence conditions.	\$220 on-the-spot fine to <i>licensee</i> . A maximum court penalty of \$2200.
4. Alcohol is only served during times specified on the liquor licence and within the designated licensed area of the club	Breach of licence conditions.	\$1100 on-the-spot fine to <i>licensee</i> for each unit of alcohol sold by way of a compliance notice, penalty action or complaint action. A maximum court penalty of \$11,000.
5. Licensee (or nominated person) is always present when alcohol is served	Breach of licence conditions.	\$1100 on-the-spot fine to <i>licensee</i> for each unit of alcohol sold by way of a compliance notice, penalty action or complaint action. A maximum court penalty of \$11,000.
6. Tap water is provided free of charge	Breach of licence conditions.	\$1100 on-the-spot fine to <i>licensee</i> by way of a compliance notice, penalty action or complaint action. A maximum court penalty of \$11,000.
7. People aged under 18 years do not serve alcohol	If a minor serves alcohol.	\$550 on-the-spot fine to <i>licensee</i> . A maximum court penalty of \$5500.
8. ID checks are conducted on people who appear to be under the age of 25 years, and people aged under 18 years are not served alcohol	Selling alcohol to minors.	\$1100 on-the-spot fine to <i>licensee</i> and an additional \$1100 on-the-spot fine to <i>venue staff</i> who sold/supplied alcohol to a minor by way of a compliance notice, penalty action or complaint action. A maximum penalty of \$11,000 or 12 months imprisonment or both to <i>licensee</i> .
9. All entrances to the club are monitored by staff/volunteers and intoxicated people are not permitted to enter the premises	Permitting intoxication.	\$1100 on-the-spot fine to <i>licensee</i> for each unit of alcohol sold by way of a compliance notice, penalty action or complaint action. A maximum court penalty of \$11,000.

Criteria	Law	Fine
10. Intoxicated people are not served alcohol and are not permitted to remain on the premises (after appropriate safe transport options are offered)	Supply alcohol to an intoxicated person.	\$1100 on-the-spot fine to <i>licensee</i> and an additional \$1100 on-the-spot fine to <i>venue staff</i> who sold/supplied alcohol to an intoxicated person by way of a compliance notice, penalty action or complaint action. A maximum penalty of \$11,000 or 12 months imprisonment or both to <i>licensee</i> .
11. Alcohol sold at the club is only consumed at the club (not taken away)	Breach of licence conditions.	\$1100 on-the-spot fine to <i>licensee</i> for each unit of alcohol sold by way of a compliance notice, penalty action or complaint action. A maximum court penalty of \$11,000.
12. All bar servers have undertaken an accredited responsible service of alcohol (RSA) training course	Sell or supply liquor if not RSA trained.	\$220 on-the-spot fine to <i>venue staff</i> who are not RSA trained and an additional \$1100 on-the-spot fine to <i>licensee</i> . If the <i>licensee</i> is not RSA trained an on-the-spot fine of \$1100 applies.
13. The club maintains an RSA register	If licensee or staff member cannot produce the RSA register on demand.	\$1100 on-the-spot fine to <i>licensee</i> and \$550 on-the-spot fine to <i>venue staff</i> who cannot produce the RSA register on demand.

OLGR / Police attending sporting fixtures

- (a) Where is licensee (If absent advise Licensing Police (Newcastle or Lake Macquarie of the name of who has been delegated the role)
- (b) Produce the license
- (c) Produce the copies of RSA certificates
- (d) Produce the alcohol incident register
- (e) Signage ... correct 2007 or later complies
- (f) Opening alcohol at time of supply
- (g) No under-aged being supplied
- (h) No secondary supply even by parents to their children
- (i) No taking alcohol away from ground
- (j) Compliance with conditions
- (k) Compliance with dates nominated on license
- (l) Not serve intoxicated persons
