WHS024 Management of Sports Facilities

Legal Application: WHS Act 2011 s.19 contains the primary duty of a 'person conducting a business or undertaking' (PCBU) to ensure so far as is reasonably practicable the health and safety of workers and others in the workplace.

Purpose

To ensure all workers engaged at the Club work safely in and around the Sports Facility

Scope

This procedure applies to all workers engaged at the Club. The Goulburn Club's only sporting facility is a single squash court.

Responsibilities

- The Squash Court is managed on-line. Users of the squash court are given an entry code, and pay on an honesty based system leaving money in a safe security box.
- There are no chemicals or plant involved in running the squash court.
- Club workers are physically not involved in running or managing the squash court.

Procedures

The management of the squash court does not involve any WHS related issues for workers.

The Goulburn Club Board is responsible for both strategic and operational management of the club. Therefore the Goulburn Club Board covers all roles covered by the following terms: a Person Conducting a Business or Undertaking ('PCBU'), Officers and Directors, Managers as well as workers.
