Art Exhibitions and Openings at the Goulburn Club

All artwork is insured as 'contents' within our own insurance coverage. it would be helpful if you provided us with a listing of works and your own estimated values.

If you are interested in selling artwork at the club, please provide your own placards with artwork information and prices.

We have a 20% commission on art sales. The artist must supply bank details to allow direct deposit of 80% of sales to the artist at the conclusion of the exhibition

Openings are easiest on Thursday and Friday evenings, as the Club volunteers are already scheduled to operate the Club and tend the bar. Many artists in the past have installed exhibitions on Thursday and held openings the next night (Friday).

Openings scheduled for other days will need more lead time to schedule available Club volunteers.

Openings on Thursday evenings: Please note that there are other groups (GRUB Ukulele band, writers' groups, etc.) having weekly meetings in other/adjoining rooms. Some artists have enjoyed the additional activity, interest and ambient music that these groups provide.

Openings on Friday evenings: Please note that The Goulburn Club schedules music events to begin at 7:30 on most Friday evenings. Openings can be scheduled earlier in the evening if that suits the artists. Music events typically occur in the Durack room, so the Gallery room and Gallery Annex are free to continue with art exhibition openings. Openings and concerts can run concurrently and sometimes become a wonderful mix of events and audiences. Artists and coordinators are advised to check with the Club's music booking coordinator (music@goulburnclub.com.au) to avoid conflicts when smaller musical events may be booked to occur in the gallery room.

The artist generally supplies the nibblies and we supply up to 4 bottes of white and red wine (usually 2 bottles each of house red and white). Then it is 'purchase at the bar' as per usual.

Artists may arrange for musicians to provide ambient entertainment for their event. Please advise the Goulburn Club if this is being arranged. Musicians at art openings will not receive payment from the Goulburn club for their performance. The Goulburn club may advise against additional ambient music if the event is scheduled on a night with other (louder) music acts scheduled to perform, as it may result in unpleasant dissonance.

Artists wishing to write a brief media announcement and description of the Exhibition and Opening may do so. Artists must send these to the Goulburn Club's exhibitions coordinator. It may then be edited for length and content. Artists and coordinators may work together to send announcements to local media (Goulburn Post, Tourist Info centre, related websites and social media, etc.).
