



HOUSE POLICY

1. By Law

- 1.1 The Club must ensure no intoxicated person is on Club premises. Intoxicated means that a person is noticeably affected by alcohol.
- 1.2 The Club takes responsibility to prevent intoxication. When noticed, staff can: refuse service; ask the patron to leave; or call the Police.
- 1.3 Staff may refuse to sell or supply alcohol to anyone becoming intoxicated.
- 1.4 Alcohol will not be provided to anyone aged under 18. Proof of age must be provided by any person suspected of being aged under 18.

2. Behaviour

- 2.1 The Club will eject a patron who is: violent; disorderly; smoking in a non-smoking area; or using illicit drugs.
- 2.2 Everyone at the Goulburn Club is to be treated with respect and fairness and without harassment.
- 2.3 The Club promotes a safe and friendly atmosphere by caring for patron safety and having trained and courteous staff.

3. Responsible Promotions

- 3.1 The Club is a member of the Goulburn Liquor Accord and complies with the essence of the Accord.
- 3.2 The Club will not have promotional material that encourages the excessive consumption of alcohol.
- 3.3 The Club promotes the responsible service of alcohol by having non-alcoholic drinks and food always available.

4. Customers / Community

- 4.1 The Club does not serve shots or doubles.
- 4.2 The Club does not permit the bringing of any alcoholic or soft drinks into the premises.
- 4.3 The Club's Bar Manager shall determine when the bar shall be closed, in accordance with license requirements.
- 4.4 In general, persons entering the Club shall be fully clothed in neat, clean and modest attire. The Club supervisor may refuse entry to persons whose dress may cause offence.
