

Safe Operating Procedure

SMALL TOOLS

DO NOT USE A POWER TOOL UNLESS YOU ARE COMPETENT

Personal Protective Equipment

1. Eye Protection, Hearing Protection, Appropriate Footwear.

Possible Injuries

- 1. Electrocution
- 2. Cuts and abrasions

Checks Prior to Operation

- 1. Check electrical connections, power cords, and power tool for damage. Do not use damaged equipment
- 2. Make sure the tool is sharp.
- 3. Clear the area of debris which could interfere with the work.

How to avoid injury

- 1. Wear PPE appropriate to the task. Keep hair confined.
- 2. Adopt an evenly balanced and comfortable working position.
- 3. For repetitive tasks, take breaks or rotate jobs with co-workers.
- 4. If only one hand is required to operate the tool, make sure that the other hand is kept clear of the cutting head or jaws.
- 5. Keep the area clear of off-cuts, etc.
- 6. Make sure you know the correct technique for operating the tool.
