The Goulburn Club Board have discussed the potential threat of COVID-19 Virus.

As of today, and this may change tomorrow, the Goulburn Club will stay open Thursday, Friday and Sunday afternoons.

If music groups wish to cancel then that is their right to do so. It is recommended however that music groups play in the Durack Room where there is more room. If booked musicians cancel then it will be advertised via the Newsletter.

The club will open at normal times but may close early at the discretion of the bar manager if we have no patrons.

The Goulburn Club has put in place the following mitigation strategies:

1. Hand Sanitisers will be available throughout the club.
2. Members and guests will be asked at the front door to use sanitisers before entering the club.
3. All surfaces will be wiped down with a bleach base solution. This includes table chairs, benches, toilets, stair railing, door handles, music stands.
4. Gloves and wipes will be available on the middle landing.
5. All bottles entering the bar will be wiped with a bleach base solution.
6. Glasses will be offered to members and guests for bottled beer and cider.
7. Bar staff will wash hands between each sale.

If members and guests are concerned we recommend self exclusion.
